*Well, if you fished the buoy 20 area on the last two days of the flounder season, most likely you did not fare well. That's because the flatties seemed to have moved to the buoy 15 area. I had reports of some good steady fishing for the handful of boats working there the last two days of the season.*

*Bass and bluefish continues to be the stronghold in the bay providing plenty of action at the inlet, at the cuts and in the Back Bay. Poppers seem to have the edge this time of year on the blues, while clam and live bunker do their thing on the striper population.*

*Fluke have been a tough pick in the ocean as of late and I suspect it will continue to do so with Sunday night's storm leaving a big heave in its trail. The bay bite has been pretty good in the West Cut when conditions prevailed this week with some impressive size fish in the mix.*

*If you are looking to fill a bucket of tasty blue claws head for the docks as there are plenty of the crustaceans around.*
