Well the flounder finally began to bite on Wednesday and got better as the week went on. Hopefully the bite will be at peak for the tournament on Saturday. Bays 20 to 23 has been the area of assault with our own Dean Delle Donne slamming 9 nice fat fish at bay 20 on Thursday. Paul Nilsson and his dad were in the area as well and were able to pull four flatties without the help of cham. Both of our boys worked the top of the tide.

Fluke are eating and eating well in the Narrows this week with plenty of real nice fish coming from the bays 8 through 10 areas. Fluke to 8 pounds have been gladly accepting backtails, squid and spearing on the outgoing tide. The ocean bite has been sporadic, probably due to the southeast swells from the low pressure system down south. Once the ocean finally settles, the bite should turn back on.

Bluefish continue to entertain all those looking for them, and some big slammers as well. Bass are hot and heavy on clams at the inlet with a few keepers among a hoard of shorties.
