*Fluke continues to surprise in the bay this week with the amount of keepers taken. John B and Bob S combined for 7 keepers to nearly 8 pounds. Anywhere from buoy 11 to Harts Cove has been producing.*

*Blue fin tuna have arrived and are thick and heavy 3 to 6 miles south of the inlet.*
