Hey you guys want a change of pace? Head over to the Narrows with worms and squid strips on hi-lo rigs and there are lots of summer weakfish, legal porgies and some small kingfish near the buoy 8 area. If nothing else, the porgies and kingfish make great striper bait when live lined.
